- it comprises at least 6 vendors;
- it operates for at least 2 hours in a day, at least 4 times per year, but no more than twice a week.

I understand that the general manager may, by written notice to a licensee to whom an authorization was issued, cancel the authorization if, in the general manager's opinion,

- (a) the circumstances on the basis of which the authorization was applied for and issued have changed so that they no longer meet the requirements of this Act or the regulations for issue of the authorization,
- (b) the circumstances on the basis of which the authorization was issued did not exist at the time the authorization was issued,
- (c) the authorization was issued in error, or
- (d) the event in relation to which the authorization was issued could pose a threat to public safety.

If I fail to disclose a material fact required on the event submission page, or make a false or misleading statement, I commit an offence which could result in the suspension or cancellation of the licence - Liquor Control and Licensing Regulation, Section 18.5(3).
