1.) <u>Upcoming Applications</u>

- The LUC has received 2 calls regarding land use applications.
 - a) Garden Suite Application (Zebra Designs) 1509 Oaklands Avenue
 - Application would be for rezoning.
 - Applicant inquired about the approach and process for submitting an application.
 - Applicant was told they would need to fill out a land use meeting request form.
 - Applicant is comfortable to wait until January 2016 to schedule a land use meeting.

2.) Tracking Spreadsheet

- The LUC discussed developing a tracking spreadsheet of all the applications the committee receives.
- The spreadsheet would be a Google document.
- Ben indicated he would create a draft of the spreadsheet and Roberto would maintain the spreadsheet by including information as new applications are submitted or updating the status of previous applications.

- Information to include on the spreadsheet:
 - who applicant and/or owner;
 - what type of application;
 - what the applicant is applying for;
 - dates of meetings;
 - has information been sent to the city; and
 - status of the application

3.) Land Use Application Process

- Ben and Jeff provided information on how the land use application process works.
- The LUC is contacted by the applicant during the planning stage of the proposed development.
- The applicant would discuss with the LUC about the type of meeting they should be holding:
 - the size of the project would determine the type and size of the meeting/community engagement.
- The LUC will set up a meeting date.
- Notes are taken during the meeting, which are then passed on to the community liaison.
- When an application is submitted, it is reviewed against the Official Community Plan and the Oaklands Neighbourhood Association Strategic Plan.
- The LUC represents the opinions and views of the community.

4.) Volunteers

- A discussion was held on seeking potential volunteers to help out with the LUC.
- Specific roles of volunteers would include:
 - help facilitate meetings with applicants (need at least 2 people present,
 1 to facilitate the meeting and 1 to take notes); and
 - help maintain the tracking spreadsheet and LUC information on the Oaklands Neighbourhood Association website:
 - make information available,
 - include meeting minutes,
 - provide information from LUC meetings, and
 - examples of projects the LUC worked on.

5.) Oaklands Neighbourhood Association Board Meeting

- The Oaklands Neighbourhood Association Board Meeting was held on Tuesday, November 24, 2015.
- A proposal was brought forward about making use of vacant land in the neighbourhood for affordable housing units:

- the Victoria Micro-Housing Society made a presentation to the board regarding vacant land to build affordable housing units.
- The LUC will follow-up with the Victoria Micro-Housing Society.

6.) Large Projects

- Plans regarding affordable housing in Oaklands Neighbourhood were discussed.
- Consultation with the community would need to be conducted to determine what the community's views are regarding affordable housing.
- The LUC suggested the Victoria Micro-Housing Society could host a discussion with the community regarding affordable housing in the new year (2016).

7.) Next LUC Meeting

- A date for the official LUC meeting with Zebra Designs to discuss their application was determined:
 - The meeting would be held on January 5, 2016 at 6:30 pm PST.
